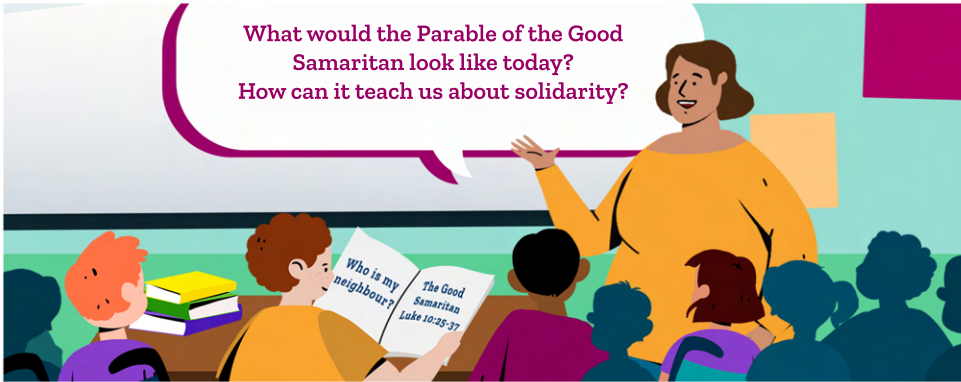


Solidarity

Solidarity is:

- Not about feeling sorry for someone (sympathy)
- A commitment to the good of all
- A way of saying "I am with you"

The parable asks us to look beyond social or other barriers and love our neighbour. To be the person who responds and acts with love.
